2pm	4pm	Outside Space Cafe	Mila + Lucas	Mila + Lucas are an indie-folk inspired singer/songwriter duo based in Melbourne. Their music uses intricate guitar parts and lyrics that tell thoughtful stories to take their audience on an intimate journey. Look out as their first release will be with you soon :)
2pm	4pm	Outside Al Naturale	Anna Morley	Anna's music is an eclectic fusion of electro-acoustic vibes with ambient overtones, woven together by fresh minimal grooves. On stage Anna blends a unique gamut of instrumentation including the vibraphone, keys and electronic beats and samples within her compositions.

Their self-produced soul-infused hits shine alongside contemporary RnB fusion artists RAYE and Cleo Sol. Known for her incredible whistle notes, four-octave vocal range and harmony stacks, 90's R&B flair and warm production makes EMEREE unmissable. Feeling both warmly familiar and undeniably unique in 2025 is no mean feat. As a writer, her lyrics often explore the realms of sexual identity and female empowerment with addictive honesty. With her works generating over 50 million streams on Spotify and millions of views on Tiktok, EMEREE is solidifying herself as one-to-watch in the Australian industry.
4pm	6pm	Outside Mahjong / Lucien	QiQi	QiQi weaves a vibrant blend of original guzheng music, jazz, contemporary fusion, and traditional Chinese folk, creating a lively and dynamic musical experience
4pm	6pm	Outside Blu Oyster / St Kilda Cellars / Leos	Laura de Elvia	Laura de Elvira is a Melbourne-born musician with a special connection to Europe through heritage and lived experience. While Flamenco guitar has her heart, her music spans multiple styles and languages, and will transport you overseas for an hour or two!

Since her arrival in Australia, she has performed at various concert venues across VIC and NSW and toured the Australian festival circuit. Performing a mix of kick-ass traditional Irish tunes & soul stirring folk songs, Maggie gives a fresh perspective to a century spanning tradition, transporting you on a journey from New York dance halls of the 1920s to the modern day. Maggie will soon be releasing her first solo album, Ebb And Flow, later this year.

Liana plays the electro-acoustic pedal harp, coupled with amplification and analogue effects pedals to extend the sonority of her instrument. Her music envelopes the listener into a world of intriguing harp harmonies, tactile beats and soul-evoking lyrics
